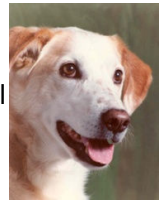
Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to animals (SPCA). Founded in 1824. Granted Royal status (RSPCA) in 1840 by Queen Victoria.
